The Grant Writer will assemble and submit grant requests, establish and maintain personal contact and relationships with granter contacts, conduct prospect research, and maintain a calendar of submissions and other deadlines.

- Develop/write grant proposals to foundations and grant-making organizations
- Assemble/submit grant requests, including letters, proposals, budgets, and presentations
- Conduct prospect research
- Report progress in grant research, grant submission and outcome to General Manager
