#### **About Anteros**

The Anteros Arts Foundation is a charity for education and the promotion of the arts in Norfolk. Housed in an ancient Tudor merchant's house that is grade 2\* listed, we teach short courses in fine art skills alongside the eight-month Anteros Arts Diploma, hire out rooms and hire out gallery space for a rotating programme of exhibitions from local artists.

### The Role

We are looking for volunteers to help support the delivery of a variety of different art classes at Anteros. You will help set up for the class, be on hand throughout the class to gather extra materials and support the tutor and students, and then help tidy up after class, ensuring that feedback forms are completed before students leave. You may also be required to film classes as we move to online offers. It is a practical role involving handling easels, art materials, chairs etc but gives you the opportunity to sit in on high quality art classes.
